Gaganyaan tests

Taking yet another leap forward in its maiden human flight mission Gaganyaan, the Indian Space Agency successfully conducted a series of Droque Parachute Deployment Tests for three days in collaboration with Aerial Delivery Research and Development Establishment (ADRDE)/DRDO for a controlled descent that further accentuated the progress of the mission's parachute system development.

The successful tests confirmed the readiness for integration into the upcoming Test Vehicle-D1 mission. ISRO sources on Friday night said the tests were conducted by the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) from August 8 to 10 at Chandigarh.

It successfully conducted a series of Droque Parachute Deployment Tests at the Rail Track Rocket Sled (RTRS) facility of the Terminal Ballistics Research Laboratory, Chandigarh, during August 8-10, 2023.

The tests were conducted in collaboration with Aerial Delivery Research and Development Establishment (ADRDE)/DRDO.

The Gaganyaan mission entails the safe transportation of astronauts to space and back in a controlled descent.

A crucial component of this mission is the

deployment of drogue parachutes, which play a pivotal role in stabilizing the crew module and reducing its velocity to a safe level during re-entry.

Droque parachutes, packed within pyro-based devices known as mortars, are ingeniously designed to eject the parachutes into the air upon command. These conical ribbon-type parachutes, boasting a diameter of 5.8 meters, employ a single-stage reefing mechanism, ingeniously minimising canopy area and mitigating opening shock, ensuring a smooth and controlled descent.

During the three comprehensive tests conducted at the RTRS facility, a range of real-world scenarios were simulated to rigorously evaluate the performance and reliability of the drogue parachutes. The first test simulated the maximum reefed load, marking a groundbreaking introduction of reefing in a mortar-deployed parachute within India. The second test emulated the maximum disreefed load, while the third test showcased the deployment of the drogue parachute under conditions mirroring the maximum angle of attack experienced by the Crew Module during its mission.

These successful

RTRS tests serve as a critical qualification milestone for the drogue parachutes, confirming their readiness for integration into the upcoming Test Vehicle-D1 mission. Notably, earlier this year, the RTRS tests of Pilot and Apex cover separation parachutes were also conducted, further accentuating the progress of the Gaganyaan mission's parachute system development.

The intricate parachute sequence for the Gaganyaan crew module's deceleration system encompasses a total of 10 parachutes. The sequence commences with the deployment of two Apex cover separation parachutes, followed by the stabilization achieved through the deployment of two drogue parachutes. Upon release of the drogue parachutes, the mission transitions into the extraction phase, with three Pilot chutes individually extracting three main parachutes, a pivotal step in reducing the Crew Module's speed to safe levels for a secure landing

American hand seen in Imran's ouster as PM

Bangla PM too complains of US meddling

Dhaka, Aug 12: The USA had threatened to isolate Pakistan if Imran Khan was not removed from the post of Prime Minister.

There was a decision at a secret meeting of the US State Department to topple Imran Khan as Pakistan remained neutral on the Russia-Ukraine war.

This was revealed in a report by the American-based media 'The Intercept' citing official documents of Pakistan.

According to the documents, US Assistant Secretary for Central and South Asian Affairs Donald Lu expressed anger over Pakistan's position in the Russia-Ukraine war in a secret meeting.

Lu warned that the West's relationship with Pakistan would deteriorate if the position on the war did not change.

A meeting was held between the two officials of the USA

Department of State and Pakistani Embassy in the USA on March 7 last year. There, the issue of power struggle between the Pakistan army and the opposition with Pakistan's former Prime Minister Imran Khan was discussed.

Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina made similar comments a few days ago. She directly said "America wants to remove me".

While speaking at a discussion meeting at the National Press Club on August 9, 2023 Bangladesh Foreign Minister A.K. Abdul Momen also said foreigners are conspiring against the Government of Bangladesh. Former Pakistan Prime Minister Imran and Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina have similar statements.

When asked in a regular press briefing about this document, US State Department spokesman Matthew Miller said, "This

comment does not imply that the US is determining who will be the leader of Pakistan." Miller did not agree to say anything in detail about that secret meeting.

According to secret documents, at the end of the meeting, the then Pakistani ambassador to the US, Asad Majeed Khan, said the Russia-Ukraine war would not affect the relationship between Islamabad and Washington. Meanwhile, Lu said that the relationship will be normal only after Imran is removed.

The day after that secret meeting in the United States, i.e. on March 8, 2021, the no-confidence vote

against Imran started in Pakistan's Parliament. A month later, Imran lost power.

Imran visited Moscow after the start of Russia-Ukraine war in February last year. Within two weeks, Pakistan government and US State Department officials sat in the meeting. Because the United States was angry with Imran's visit to Moscow.

A day before this meeting Imran said in a rally, "Are we slaves? What do you think? We are friends of Russia and the United States. We are friends of China. Europe is also a friend. We are not part of any coalition."

Ukraine pilots need to learn English before F16 training

Kyiv, Aug 12: A first group of six Ukrainian pilots will complete their training on F-16 fighter jets in the summer of 2024 at the earliest because they will have to take four-month English courses to learn technical terms, the Washington Post newspaper reported on Friday, citing Ukrainian officials.

The report said that the pilots would start training on F-16 fighters only in January 2024 and that preparation would take six months. The second group of pilots will receive training no earlier than in late 2024, the newspaper reported.

The first group consisting of six pilots makes up half of the aviation squadron and two other pilots are identified as reserve candidates, the report added.

Meanwhile, Ukraine is concerned over ongoing tensions between Kyiv and its allies about "the best way" to position the forces against "a

far larger, better-armed" Russian force, the report added. In July, Pentagon's Joint Staff Director for Operations Lt. Gen. Douglas Sims II said battlefield conditions in Ukraine were not "ideal" for the use of F-16 fighter jets, given Russia's continued air defence capabilities.

Western allies began delivering weapons to Ukraine after Russia launched its military operation there in February 2022. Their support has evolved from light artillery munitions and training to heavier weapons. In recent months, Ukraine has been pushing its donors to provide fighter jets. Russia has consistently warned against further arms deliveries to Kyiv.
